Learning programmes

Examples:

SCS-based courses

VQP courses

- Qualifications attained through learning programmes that are offered by education & training providers and in-house training programmes offered by enterprises / organisations / government departments
- accredited by the Accreditation Authority i.e. Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) or by institutions with self-accrediting status

A category of learning programmes designed based on the Specification of Competency Standards (SCS) developed by industries implementing QF, in which the learning contents are directly related to the knowledge and skills required in the workplace

Another category of learning programmes developed based on the required competencies of different job roles on the Vocational Qualifications Pathway (VQP) developed by industries implementing QF

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) qualifications

Professional qualifications

- Qualifications issued by RPL Assessment Agencies in recognition of work experiences and competencies acquired by industry practitioners at the workplace and are attained without undergoing a learning programme
- RPL qualifications are within QF levels 1 to 4

- Qualifications attained through assessments (e.g. examinations, trade tests) and are not underpinned by learning programmes
- issued by local professional and regulatory bodies which have gone through accreditation and appointed by the Secretary for Education
