	<ul> <li>Know about common aesthetic treatments (including but not limited to laser, HIFU, RF, micro needle, AHA, cryo-induced lipolysis/ laser-induced lipolysis, microcurrent, etc.) with the use of beauty products</li> <li>Understand the basic theories of using aesthetic products before performing beauty treatments :         <ul> <li>Control chronic inflammation</li> <li>Stabilize skin melanocytes to prevent pigmentation</li> <li>Restore the maturation cycle of skin stratum corneum</li> <li>Enhance skin resistance</li> <li>Enhance skin is ability to restore and secret own moisture</li> <li>Stabilize overactive sebum secretion</li> <li>Explain how whitening ingredients stabilize and reduce the activity of melanocytes by illustrating the process and pathological causes of melanin production in the skin</li> </ul> </li> <li>Know about how to refer to and explain the relevant manuals of functional skincare products and cosmeceutical products, and understand the mechanism of their ingredients, such as introducing how bioengineering and bioinformatics catalyse the development of functional skincare products to use with the beauty treatment, or choose the proper aesthetic products to use with the beauty products:         <ul> <li>Compatibility, such as: The micro-current introduction device is only suitable for high-conductivity serum; Active growth factor, vitamin C may lose its activity in a certain pH environment, etc.</li> <li>Safety, such as: Traematic or invasive treatments could only be applied with sterile or disinfected beauty products</li> <li>Complementary, such as : unsuitable to over-moisturize before laser treatment, unsuitable to use masks with acidic or softening effect after the treatment of AHA</li> <li>Understand the basic theories of using aesthetic products after beauty treatments:             <ul> <li>Able to relieve inflam</li></ul></li></ul></li></ul>

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	<ul> <li>Stabilize sebum secretion and how to reduce clogged pores</li> <li>Understand the common side effects of beauty treatments and their causes, such as: Burning sensation, Slight redness         <ul> <li>Understand the skin reactions that may occur after beauty treatments or the corresponding treatment methods and the non-pharmaceutical and (prescribed by qualified person) pharmaceutical ingredients that may be used, such as aloe vera, oatmeal, (medicine) steroids, etc.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
