	 Understand and utilize high-intensity focused ultrasound instrument, including different types of high-intensity focused ultrasound instrument and treatment heads, including: higher energy, lower energy, linear, spiral, and different depth of focus, etc. Achieve related effects through the operation of high-intensity focused ultrasound, such as: lifting facial contours, tightening of the superficial Musculo-aponeurotic system, tightening the dermis, etc. Recognize that high-intensity focused ultrasound has different stages of influence and normal reactions on the skin, subcutaneous tissues and body tissues, such as thermal injury formation, tissue coagulation, inflammation, skin repair, collagen proliferation and soft tissue reorganization, etc.
