Range	This unit of competency is applicable to airlines, air cargo terminals, freight forwarders or security companies providing cargo inspection service. Practitioners should be capable to implement procedures for air freight security according to regulator's requirements.

Possess the knowledge of air freight security inspection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know the freight security operation</li> <li>• Understand the measures and procedures for cargo security control</li> <li>• Understand the system and requirements for cargo security monitoring</li> <li>• Understand the use and characteristics of cargo inspection instruments</li> <li>• Understand messages and indications shown on the cargo inspection instruments</li> <li>• Possess occupational safety knowledge in using inspection instruments</li> <li>• Understand global requirement and development and impact on local operations</li> <li>• Understand maintenance and calibration of instruments</li> </ul> <p>2. Implement security inspection of air cargo with instruments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use suitable instruments to inspect cargo</li> <li>• Read the messages, indications or instructions shown on the instrument to judge whether the cargo is a restricted article, suspicious item, complied with regulators' requirements or has been interfered illegally</li> <li>• Send the inspection report to relevant parties according to instructions and inspection results</li> <li>• Fill in relevant documents or enter data into a computer as inspection record</li> <li>• Implement contingency measures for protection, isolation, etc. if any abnormalities are found, or report to superior or regulators</li> <li>• Analyse historical data of the company to measure the performance and ensure to meet related regulatory requirement</li> <li>• Provide updated information to the company for short-term, mid-term and long-term plan on the inspection of air cargo</li> </ul>
