3. Range	This unit of competency is applicable to terminals, shipping companies, mid-stream operators or stevedore companies. Practitioners should be capable to arrange for handling of maritime goods.

Competency	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Performance Requirements</u></p> <p>6.1 Knowledge of handling/stowing of maritime goods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ Understand the company's role and responsibility in cargo handling◆ Understand the coordination of carriers, handling/stowing tools, containers and pallet, and ancillary tools in cargo handling◆ Understand the impact of the weather and working environment on operation◆ Understand the documents required for shipping and transportation, relevant procedures and processes◆ Understand the process and code of cargo handling◆ Understand the working environment, and safety measures and regulations◆ Master the calculation of the manpower, time, equipment and costs required for cargo handling◆ Understand resources allocation methods◆ Understand the requirements related to packaging, labelling, marking of maritime goods

	<p>6.2 Arrange for handling of maritime goods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Understand the types of container packing and bulk packing, and relevant restrictions ◆ Send or deploy handling/stowing equipment and goods to designated locations ◆ Arrange sufficient and appropriate equipment, and manpower to handle the goods; formulate work sequences and processes ◆ Draw up long-term manpower deployment and work schedules and prepare sufficient handling equipment in the case of prolonged work ◆ Monitor and assess the progress of cargo handling ◆ Decide on the deployment of resources and manpower to deal with emergencies ◆ Inform relevant companies if the handling and stowing work cannot be completed as scheduled ◆ Verify the cargo list and check the appearance and quantity against the list ◆ Keep a record of the loaded/unloaded cargoes by completing forms or checklists
7. Assessment Criteria	<p>The integrated outcome requirements of this unit of competency are:</p> <p>(i) Capable to arrange and coordinate the resources and manpower required for cargo loading / unloading; to complete the handling of maritime goods efficiently and safely; and</p> <p>(ii) Capable to formulate an efficient process for cargo loading / unloading handling and distribute work sequence instructions to staff.</p>
