Practitioners should be capable to perform safety management for working in terminal's cargo handling area according to safety guidelines and procedures of the company.

Competency	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Performance Requirements</u></p> <p>6.1 Knowledge of work safety in terminal's cargo handling area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Understand the concept of terminal's cargo handling area and types of operation, such as container terminal, cargo working area, container yard, bulk cargo distribution zone, etc.</li> <li>◆ Understand characteristics in the design of terminal's cargo handling area, such as fenceless shore of the cargo working area, the facility of gangway, etc.</li> <li>◆ Be familiar with codes of practice for terminal's cargo handling area issued by regulators and relevant legislations</li> <li>◆ Understand the cargo handling or transport facilities that may be used in terminal's cargo handling area, and their area of operation and characteristics</li> <li>◆ Understand the risks and accidents that may occur in terminal's cargo handling area, such as falling into the sea and being hit by container</li> </ul>

	<p data-bbox="384 465 751 712">6.2 Implement safety procedures for working in terminal's cargo area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="767 226 1461 416">◆ Understand the influence of the working environment and weather of terminal's cargo area on work, such as strong wind, thunderbolt, tidal flow, etc.</li> <li data-bbox="767 465 1461 712">◆ Establish safe means of access to terminal's cargo handling area, including safety signs in the workplace, walkway, container storage area, separation line, one-way traffic, etc.</li> <li data-bbox="767 734 1461 768">◆ Establish heavy machinery operation area</li> <li data-bbox="767 790 1461 869">◆ Keep the passage and operation field clean and barrier free</li> <li data-bbox="767 891 1461 969">◆ Set up traffic control counter and put on suitable traffic signs</li> <li data-bbox="767 992 1461 1193">◆ Ensure that only staff of the workplace can have the access, and there are qualified personnel who have gone through safety training</li> <li data-bbox="767 1216 1461 1249">◆ Conduct pre- and post-work briefings</li> <li data-bbox="767 1272 1461 1406">◆ Inspect the working behavior of the staff to see whether it meets the safety requirements</li> <li data-bbox="767 1429 1461 1563">◆ Inspect the workplace to see whether the environment is suitable, including the lighting and ventilation</li> <li data-bbox="767 1585 1461 1720">◆ Inspect the workplace to see whether the fire fighting equipment and instructions are adequate</li> <li data-bbox="767 1742 1461 1877">◆ Inspect the workplace to see whether the safety facilities and equipment, such as fences and ladders, are suitable</li> <li data-bbox="767 1899 1461 1933">◆ Conduct general safety inspections</li> <li data-bbox="767 1955 1461 2045">◆ Report on damaged or inadequate tools, facilities and equipment</li> </ul>
