Practitioners should be capable of efficiently and effectively combining and consolidating freights with reference to operating procedures, and safety requirements and regulations (e.g. OSH requirements, Dangerous Goods regulations).

Competency	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Performance Requirements:</u></p> <p>6.1 Knowledge of freight consolidation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Possess basic knowledge of cargo handling</li> <li>• Know about the operations of freight consolidation</li> <li>• Understand company policy and procedures</li> <li>• Understand relevant regulatory requirements</li> <li>• Assess requirements of freight consolidation</li> <li>• Assess capacity and capability of different transport modes against proposed tasks</li> <li>• Evaluate individual consignment loads to identify relevant information needed to consolidate cargo</li> <li>• Analyse information to determine the possibility to carry out freight consolidation</li> <li>• Ensure cargo packaging requirements in compliance with workplace and regulatory requirements</li> <li>• Plan procedures for the cargo loading with reference to relevant regulatory requirements and industry practices.</li> <li>• Calculate volumes and dimensions of proposed consolidation</li> <li>• Ensure proposed consolidation can fully cover its freight cost payable to carrier</li> <li>• Ensure proposed consolidation is in lined with carrier capability and operational capacity</li> </ul> <p>6.2.2 Prepare consignment documentation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepare consignment documentation for consolidated cargo</li> <li>• Document cargo labelling requirements according to customer requirements, relevant local and international regulations (e.g. customs requirements and regulations) and workplace requirements</li> <li>• Complete, file and store consignment documentation</li> <li>• Handle special cargoes appropriately (e.g., considering relevant segregation requirements for dangerous goods)</li> </ul>
