Competency	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Performance Requirements:</u></p> <p>6.1 Knowledge of handling of dangerous goods/hazardous substances</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know about the handling of dangerous goods/hazardous substances • Understand relevant regulatory requirements • Understand company policy and procedures <p>6.2.1 Access information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify, store and retrieve legislative requirements for dangerous goods/hazardous substances as required • Store information on workplace OSH policies and safe work procedures in an accessible location and manner • Explain information on relevant workplace policies and procedures, and legislative requirements • Explain information on the application of control measures and the outcome of hazard identification, and risk assessment to the work group <p>6.2.2 Identify and assess hazards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify dangerous goods/hazardous substances from provided information, e.g., class labels, manifests, and material safety data sheets • Seek confirmation from relevant personnel where hazardous substances or dangerous goods do not appear to be appropriately marked • Assess and report risks associated with the storage of identified hazardous substances or dangerous goods <p>6.2.3 Establish and implement risks control procedures</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement, monitor and review risk control measures for safe storage of dangerous goods/hazardous substances • Establish and implement work procedures to control risks • Monitor risk control procedures • Identify required improvements to existing risk control measures and report to relevant personnel
