Competency	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Performance Requirements:</u></p> <p>6.1 Relevant knowledge of cargo security</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know about principles and procedures of cargo security • Understand relevant regulatory requirements • Understand company policy and requirements <p>6.2.1 Prepare to secure cargo/container</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare and maintain work area • Report unsafe work practices or equipment to relevant personnel • Select appropriate protective equipment and clothing • Erect formwork where no lashing points exist • Interpret and read lashing plan <p>6.2.2 Lash and unlash</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify lashing points and use appropriate lashing equipment for each lashing point • Lash and secure cargo • Release, disconnect and remove fittings from the cargo when unlash • Place lashing equipment in storage areas • Ensure lashing/unlashing operations no personal injury or cargo/machinery damage in accordance with workplace requirements • Complete lashing according to lashing plan <p>6.2.3 Protect cargo from weather</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cover/uncover cargo safely to ensure no personal injury or cargo/machinery damage <p>6.2.4 Pack and unpack cargo</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify and report damaged cargo • Sort and stack cargo in correct location • Interpret numbers or marks to identify cargo • Maintain tight stow of cargo • Handle cargo safely to ensure no personal injury or cargo/machinery damage
