Apply the basic logistics, distribution and warehousing terms, codes and abbreviations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply appropriate warehousing terms to communicate with customers and colleagues effectively, e.g. receiving and conveying information • Use logistics, distribution and warehousing terms including terms related to cargo stacking; understand transportation documents and complete general reports on counting the quantity of cargoes and cargo surveying.
<p>Assessment Criteria</p>	<p>The integrated outcome requirements of this unit of competency are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capable to check and ensure all information attached to the cargo is complete and complies with standard and shipping requirements; • Capable to communicate effectively with in-service personnel or customers, for example, receiving and conveying information; • Capable to use logistics, distribution and warehousing terms, codes and abbreviations accurately; and • Capable to use logistics and warehousing terms, codes and abbreviation in general communications and document handling process in order to avoid delay, mistake or loss induced by using the wrong terms.
