Competency	<p>Performance Requirements</p> <p>1. Possess the basic knowledge of cargo consolidation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the capacity and payload of various types of containers • Understand the requirement and related information of different cargo, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shipper and consignee ○ Transshipment port, destination port ○ Number and category of goods ○ Ready time for loading and documents ○ Estimated arrival time of the goods ○ Estimated or actual cargo weight and measurement ○ Special treatment required • Understand the security, customs or operational requirements of different import countries or ports • Understand the process of shipping documents • Understand the responsibilities and document handling of combined goods <p>2. Supervise the arrangement of cargo loading, unloading and consolidation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrange the empty containers and cargo ready for loading and unloading locations, such as CFS warehouse, warehouse or terminals • Count and visually inspect the loaded or unloaded cargo. Any irregularity is found like cargo damaged, compile report to the superior immediately • Check shipping documents to understand the category and characteristics of the cargo • For cargo unloading, check the container labels and markings to grasp the risks of opening the container • For cargo loading, check the inside of the container and the door for damage, water stains, cracks and other unusual conditions
Assessment Criteria	<p>The integrated outcome requirements of this unit of competency are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capable of checking the cargo, container, and workplace to ensure loading/unloading tasks can be performed safety and accurately; and • Capable of supervising the usage of manpower, machinery and equipment properly to handle light/density, odd size cargo to load and unload the containers as per company guideline.
