Understand the common types of chilled and frozen goods, their characteristics and transportation arrangement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the storage requirement of common types of chilled and frozen goods, including candies, chocolate, fruits, juice, milk products, frozen meat and drugs • Understand the arrangement and environmental surveillance of transporting common types of frozen goods <p>2. Adopt testing methods commonly used for receiving chilled and frozen goods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the testing methods for receiving different kinds of chilled and frozen goods. The methods, for example, include examining the quality, appearance, size and weight of fruits and frozen meats; check the records of environmental surveillance, defrost test and the level of Salmonella in the food. • Determine the sampling size independently; implement the appropriate testing methods and use the right tools.
