Assess cargo for transport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assess import/export/re-export cargoes concerning their value, commodity type and size, transport modes, and classifications according to relevant import/export/re-export regulatory requirements • Advise customer of discrepancies and rectification procedures according to workplace procedures (e.g., document verification processes) <p>3. Plan and design the documentation workflow and procedure</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examine the regulatory requirements of import/export/re-export packing lists (e.g. cargo details, descriptions, dimension and weight, quantity, etc.), and commercial documents are processed/ prepared according to regulatory requirements (e.g., customs declaration) • Design cost-effective documentation workflow and procedure • Co-ordinate with related parties to implement the documentation workflow and procedure • Apply required documents as per relevant regulatory requirement • Prepare the best and most efficient process for the transaction • Review the workflow and procedure in the aspects of efficient use of resources, and comply with regulatory requirements
