Knowledge of integrated logistics support <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know about the concepts of integrated logistics support (i.e., a management process where logistics support is integrated into the lifecycle of a product from production to delivery and by which all elements of logistics support are planned, organised, and controlled) • Know about the concept of product lifecycle management • Understand relevant organisational policy and procedures 2. Prepare to implement integrated logistics support processes and procedures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify, acquire, and prepare required resources and equipment for work with reference to organisational policy and procedures (e.g., acquisition process, budget constraint, and safety requirements) • Identify and obtain information sources relevant to integrated logistics support requirements • Analyse obtained integrated logistics information to identify the requirements of integrated logistics support in product lifecycle management 3. Implement integrated logistics support processes and procedures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify performance requirements and provide recommendations to enhance the integrated logistics support • Conduct and conclude integrated logistics support activities within resource constraints • Implement integrated logistics support activities based on changing circumstances 4. Report on integrated logistics support processes and procedures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report integrated logistics support outcomes • Monitor integrated logistics support activities to ensure systems/equipment capability is maintained • Maintain integrated logistics support records • Amend and document integrated logistics support records 5. Review the implementation of integrated logistics support processes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Determine the expected outcomes of integrated logistics support • Collect relevant information to present the actual outcomes • Identify the difference between expected and actual outcomes • Provide recommendations to enhance integrated logistics support processes to obtain expected outcomes
