Know the basic knowledge of gardening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know the common hand tools used in arboriculture and gardening, the skills and steps for use of tools safely</li> <li>• Know the techniques and procedures of plant cultivation, propagation and care in properties</li> <li>• Know the basic working procedures of planting trees</li> </ul> <p>2. Carry out basic works of cultivation, beautification and care</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be able to carry out cultivation, propagation and care work such as pruning, fertilization, irrigation, soil turning and pesticide spraying in the properties as instructed</li> <li>• Be able to plant in gardens or other designated places in properties as instructed and to make labels and records for the plants</li> <li>• Be able to enclose the planting area of trees or horticulture in the properties according to the instructions of the superior</li> <li>• Be able to clean up the work site, maintain and store related tools properly</li> </ul>
Assessment Criteria	<p>The integral outcome requirements of this UoC are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be able to know the common hand tools, the skills and steps for use of tools correctly in arboriculture and gardening, know the techniques and steps of plant cultivation, propagation and care in the properties and the basic working procedures for planting trees;</li> <li>• Be able to carry out cultivation, propagation and care work in the properties by using appropriate tools as instructed; and</li> <li>• Be able to maintain and store the relevant tools properly.</li> </ul>
