



Comparability Studies on Hong Kong Qualifications Framework and Overseas Qualifications Frameworks

The Education Bureau (EDB) of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) has conducted a series of comparability studies of Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (HKQF) and four regional/national qualifications frameworks overseas (overseas QF) since 2014. A summary of the results of the studies is provided for ease of reference.

Objectives and Principles

A common objective of the studies is to establish the comparability of levels of qualifications between HKQF and each overseas QF, which include European Qualifications Framework (EQF), Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF), New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF) and Irish National Framework of Qualifications (Irish NFQ). The studies promote better understanding of the qualifications offered under HKQF, European countries, Scotland, New Zealand and Ireland, and facilitate the mobility of learners and labour as well as future discussions on mutual recognition of qualifications between Hong Kong and the corresponding places.

In all of the studies, certain guiding principles have been used to determine the comparability of the levels of QF. While there are variations necessitated by each study, the principles include the following elements in general: clear and transparent policies and roles of the authorities, robust quality assurance processes, and clear links of the levels between frameworks. The comparison tables in this leaflet depict the results in a simplified manner for quick reference.
