Title	Deploy firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation

Description	This unit of competency applies to security personnel at managerial level responsible for managing armoured transportation operations of a company holding a Type II security company licence in Hong Kong. It covers the abilities to determine the appropriate type, quantity and source as well as develop the procedures and guidelines for managing firearms and ammunition under the possession of the company for armoured transportation in Hong Kong.

Knowledge about firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand laws and regulations relevant to possession of firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation operations, which should include but not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Security and Guarding Services Ordinance, Cap 460</li> <li>○ Firearms and Ammunition Ordinance, Cap 238</li> <li>○ Occupational Safety and Health Ordinance, Cap 509 and associated regulations</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Be proficient in best practices in the storage, use and handling of firearms and ammunition</li> <li>• Be proficient in armoured transportation operations</li> <li>• Possess the analytical skills and critical thinking skills to identify issues and resolve problems and conflicts</li> <li>• Possess the people skills and communication skills to deal with others</li> <li>• Possess the literacy skills to clearly and accurately record information and activities</li> </ul> <p>2. Deploy firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation</p> <p>Be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deploy firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation in accordance to service level agreements with clients</li> <li>• Assess risks associated with the possession of firearms and ammunition</li> <li>• Ensure the company complies with all legal, regulatory and license requirements in relation to its possession of firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation</li> <li>• Ensure that a fit and proper person is appointed by the company to be responsible for all matters regarding its possession of firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation</li> <li>• Ensure that all firearms and ammunition are sourced from licensed arms dealers and registered with and approved by the Hong Kong Police</li> <li>• Ensure that the storage, use and handling of firearms and ammunition meet all legal and regulatory requirements in Hong Kong</li> <li>• Ensure that security personnel are properly trained on firearm shooting and licensed for the possession of firearms and ammunition for armoured transportation</li> <li>• Ensure that personnel involved in armoured transportation perform in accordance to the procedures and guidelines for the use and handling of firearms and ammunition</li> <li>• Monitor performance for continuous improvement</li> </ul>
Assessment Criteria	<p>The integrated outcome requirements of this UoC are the abilities to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that the storage, use and handling of firearms and ammunition under the possession of the company for armoured transportation meet the requirements of Firearms and Ammunition Ordinance, Cap 238;</li> <li>• Ensure that firearms and ammunition are stored, used and handled in accordance to relevant procedures and guidelines of the company; and</li> </ul>
